

THE GLOBAL CDM PIPELINE, AND THE CDM PROJECTS IN BANGLADESH.

Mr. Jorgen Fenhann, UNEP Riso, Denmark, presented on the Global CDM Pipeline, and the CDM projects in Bangladesh. He informed that 3188 CDM projects are now under validation and registration. He has shown how the number of CDM projects has been growing. The breakdown of CDM projects under different sectors are: renewable (62%), methane reduction & cement & coal mine (17%), supply side (EE, 10%), demand side (EE, 5%), fuel switch (3%), HFCs, PFCs & N₂O reduction (2%), afforestation & reforestation (0.5%), and transport (0.2%) sectors are prevailing. In only 11 out of the 50 Least Developed Countries (LDCs) there are now in total 25 CDM projects or 0.8% of all CDM projects. India, China, Brazil, and Mexico host most of the projects. 1831 Million CERs is projected to be issued before the end of 2012. The 4 CDM projects in the UNFCCC CDM Pipeline hosted by Bangladesh, two of them registered and two under validation. There are now 128 JI projects in the Pipeline.
