

## **INFORMATION ABOUT THE IPCC 4<sup>TH</sup> ASSESSMENT, THE INCREASING NEED FOR ACTION, THE BALI ROADMAP**

**Mr. Jorgen Fenhann**, representative of UNEP Riso, Denmark in his presentation focused on the information of the IPCC 4<sup>th</sup> assessment, the increasing need for action, the Bali Roadmap. Quoting, from the IPCC fourth assessment, he mentioned that most of the observed increase in globally-averaged temperatures since the mid-20th century is *very likely* due to the anthropogenic GHG concentrations. This is a stronger evidence since the third assessment report (TAR's) conclusion that "most of the observed warming over the last 50 years is *likely* to have been due to the increase in GHG concentrations". He also added that Projected sea level rise of 18-59 cm and Projected temperature increase of 1.1-6.4 oC(2100 compared to 1980-1999 level).
